

The 62 Group: Tailored

30 Mar-7 Jul 2024 Main Gallery

This exhibition brings together work by internationally renowned textile artist collective, the 62 Group, taking as its starting point the theme and process of tailoring. Cutting, tacking and construction techniques all feature strongly in the exhibition, whether based on the imagery of tailoring, or branching into new directions. Stitches themselves become a new language of mark or construction.

Highly personal, compelling and thought provoking themes lie behind many of the works. The life of cloth and clothing, as well as its connection through time and place, demonstrates the unique roll of textiles in our lives. Clothing as a second skin becomes a symbol for the body and also provides a means to explore identity and self-image. Tailored is a touring exhibition from Sunny Bank Mills in West Yorkshire.

Glasgow-based artist Karen Suzuki creates mixed media textile objects. The objects are freely hand stitched and allowed to develop naturally, to give them the appearance of characters who are almost alive. Inspirations include animals, soft toys and 3D animation.


CaféBar

Linda Sadler 21 Mar-14 Jul 2024 River Stairwell

Linda creates machine knitted wall pieces inspried by coral and aims to raise awareness of how climate change impacts this beautiful and colourful marine life. The process involves incorporateing wool tops (sheep fleece) into her machine knitting, felting the knitting in a washing machine, and then cutting up the felted fabric. The final process is to reconstruct the fabric by stitching the pieces together - occasionally pre-planning the design but more frequently being led by the pieces in front of her.

Jane Walkley: The Fabric of Industry

20 Apr-30 Jun 2024 Ground Floor Gallery

Jane Walkley is a visual artist who explores traditional tapestry techniques with ecofriendly resin, which she casts by hand. Walkley's work focuses on Sunny Bank where she has her studio.

Jane begins by creating clay impressions of objects with tangible meaning for the former workers. She then uses these to create moulds for the resin casts. The resin is cast in the moulds, and then woven on an upright loom.


